# NEIL COYNE VISITS GNOWANGERUP

Neil Coyne, Western Australia's first Indigenous Pro Wrestler, visited Gnowangerup last Thursday the 31st March. Neil delivered a community talk, held at the Memorial Hall, which was attended by local community members and GDHS students from years 3-10.

Neil was born in Gnowangerup and spoke about his life experiences which included being part of the Stolen Generation, living on a Mission and living in foster homes. Neil spoke of his personal struggles and the importance of accepting yourself. He explained that this enabled him to fulfil his potential, which resulted in Neil becoming WA's first Indigenous Pro-Wrestler– NC Viper. Neil has also worked on Noongar Radio for numerous years and hosts Noongar Dandjoo. Noongar Dandjoo is an award winning television series produced by Curtin University media students which focuses on gathering stories and information on Noongar Culture.

Neil answered many questions during his talk and entertained all with a wrestling demonstration. Wanslea generously provided a sausage sizzle which was thoroughly enjoyed. The day was proudly sponsored by the Gnowangerup Anglican Community Church Vintage and Pre-Loved Op-Shop. ## HAWAIIAN RIDE FOR YOUTH STOPS OFF IN GNOWANGERUP

Gnowangerup played host to the cyclists from the Hawaiian Ride for Youth on Tuesday the 5<sup>th</sup> and Thursday the 6<sup>th</sup> of April. The Hawaiian Ride for Youth is one of Australia's premier charity events that has raised \$12,718,128, since its inception in 2003. The money goes towards supporting Youth Focus and its important work preventing suicide, self-harm and depression. The bike ride is held over 5 days, with participants riding an impressive 700kms from Albany to Perth.

The riders are raising awareness of the issues behind Youth Focus by stopping in towns in the South-West, Great Southern and Wheatbelt and visiting high schools to engage and educate students. Gnowangerup District High School was lucky enough to be one of the schools targeted by the event. It was an educational and worthwhile experience for all involved. The group stayed overnight at the Training Centre and were kindly catered for by the Gnowangerup P&C. Mel Hawkins also made the trip out to give welcomed massages to some of the riders!

Does your child (or you) enjoy the thrill of motorbike riding? Do you want to improve your riding skills beyond the railway tracks, 4wd tracks or farm paddocks? If so have you considered joining a Motorcycling WA affiliated club?



How about checking out Cranbrook Districts Motorcycle Club season opener Come & Try Day on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> April, or junior coaching (4-16years) with John Young on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> April, and for those keen to travel further afield check out the Classic Motocross at Darkan on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> April.

Motocross is the off-road sport for you if slamming whoops, carving berms and flying high over jumps is your idea of fun. One of the most popular motorcycling sports, motocross is run on tracks shaped from natural terrain and produces fast, close and exciting racing.

Cranbrook Motocross Come & Try Day is open to all motocross riders (from 4 years on two wheeler motorbikes and from 5 years on quad bikes). You will need protective footwear, goggles and a helmet to take part. Plus it's free if you have never ridden at a Motorcycling WA affiliated track before!



2. **Community Grants**- for applications from \$501-\$5,000 aimed at supporting community groups with small capital projects, events, projects etc.


Community Groups within the Shire are now invited to apply for Council assistance under either category for the 2016/2017 financial year. Requests for operational funding, works-in-kind or reimbursement for expenses prior to the 2016/17 financial year will no longer be accepted under the guidelines. Furthermore, this is now the only pathway to request Council contribution for partnership funding for any project throughout the year. Please then consider all events, projects or infrastructure your community group is planning for the 2016/17 year carefully, as applications will only be open once per year.

If your community group is interested in applying for assistance under either of the grant categories, please make contact with our Manager of Community Services, at [cdo@gnowangerup.wa.gov.au](mailto:cdo@gnowangerup.wa.gov.au)) to discuss your idea. Our Community Development Officer will be available to assist with completing the application form and to answer any enquires you may have relating to the new format.

Applications are to be received no later than **4pm on Friday 6th May, 2016**. Please follow the guidelines in the application packs on how to submit your documentation. Applicants will be informed in writing of the outcome of their application, at the completion of the budget process.

## **Shire of Kent awarded \$50,000 Lotterywest grant**

A \$51,243 State Government Lotterywest grant will help pave the way towards an upgrade of Nyabing's local Memorial Park.

Member for Wagin Terry Waldron MLA presented the Lotterywest grant to representatives at the Shire of Kent, where Nyabing is located, late last week.

"This Lotterywest funding has been granted towards the upgrade of Nyabing's popular Memorial Park," Mr Waldron said.

"The aim of this upgrade is to enhance active participation and community wellbeing for children and families in Nyabing and surrounds."

Mr Waldron welcomed the Lotterywest allocation and said the local project would have widespread benefits.

"I'm pleased this funding will be used to assist with these important improvements, and I continue to support initiatives that promote community wellbeing and social cohesion in the regions," he said.

Mr Waldron congratulated the Shire of Kent and Shire President Megan Tuffley, who accepted the grant on behalf of the shire.

The town of Nyabing is located about 320 kilometres south east of Perth, in the Wagin electorate.

Each year approximately 1000 not-for-profit groups share in Lotterywest Grants totalling millions of dollars raised from the sale of Lotterywest Games.

Lotterywest grants support a variety of projects and organisations that improve the lives of Western Australians.

## **Waldron welcomes \$34,000 childcare boost for Shires of Katanning and Plantagenet**

The Shires of Katanning and Plantagenet will share in more than \$34,000 to potentially enhance the sustainability of their local childcare centres.

The two grants are part of the four-year \$9.3 million Regional Community Child Care Development Fund, made possible by the State Government's *Royalties for Regions* program.

According to Member for Wagin Terry Waldron MLA, the Shire of Katanning has been granted \$14,100 to undertake a feasibility study for a sustainable business model for Katanning Community Child Care Centre.

While, the Shire of Plantagenet will receive \$20,425 to undertake a feasibility study to assess the needs and viability of the current early education and care centre.

"Congratulations to the two Shires on their successful applications, which will assist towards the sustainability of their local childcare services," Mr Waldron said.

A further \$100,000 grant under the program will provide childcare service providers in the State's South-West with access to extra support, resources and advocacy. This grant will enable community organisation 'Investing In Our Youth' to help regional SW service providers experiencing sustainability issues.

Mr Waldron said childcare services in regional Western Australia faced unique challenges, and sometimes extra support was required to ensure their long-term viability.

"Those living in the regions should be able to access quality childcare and State Government programs like this are ensuring these centres can continue to offer essential services to locals," he said.

Regional Development Minister Terry Redman said the grants would provide strategic support to facilitate the sustainability of regional childcare centres.

"The fund is responsive to the needs of young families living in rural and regional areas," Mr Redman said.

"This is an attractive benefit for families deciding to live in regional Western Australia and I am pleased to see *Royalties for Regions* investing in the sustainability of our regions."



### Soil Testing season is on us again.

Early sampling has shown lower nitrogen levels, probably due to good crops in the past few years.

The recent summer rains may mineralise some nitrogen.

- Sampling wet soils is a challenge. If you can't get a decent sample then don't persist - wait until the soil dries out.
- If soils are damp, sample early in the week and post ASAP. The lab will dry the sample on arrival.
- Make sure samples are sealed well. Moisture may make the box undeliverable - the samples may not arrive at the lab.
