## Kaya! GDHS celebrated NAIDOC week and our Noongar language on Thursday, 29th June

We split into 5 mixed age groups - Wetj (Emu), Waalitj (Eagle), Koolbardi (Magpie), Djidi-djidi (Willy Wagtail), and Kaa-kaa (Kookaburra). They rotated through 5 activities exposing all students to our local Noongar language. The activities included a walk through Ngowanjerindj, (Gnowangerup Aboriginal Corporation Cultural Heritage Centre), singing “We are Australian” in Noongar, listening to a yarn about how the Rainbow Serpent created the Swan River, painting aboriginal symbols on paperbark, painting the different dialect regions of Noongar country, and learning about Noongar seasons (Birak - December/January, Bunaru - February/March, Djeran- April/May, Makuru - June/July, Djilba - August/September, Kambarang - October/November).

At lunch time we sampled some bush tucker – damper with kwonding (quandong) jam, yongka (kangaroo) stew, charred yongka tail, BBQ yongka burger patties, gilgies, wattle seed shortbread and wild berries shortbread.

Thank you to our NAIDOC week committee (Anne Gugiatti, Kate Oliver, Sue Kindred, Mandy Hanna, Cassy Beeck, Livia Letter, and Lola Hayward) who have done a great job of collaborating, planning and organising our activities. Thank you to the Teach, Learn, Grow (TLG) university students who helped throughout the day. Thank you to our staff and students who embraced the activities and were positive in their learning of our local traditional culture.

## Teach Learn Grow Volunteers Visit GDHS

On Monday the 26th of June, Gnowangerup welcomed a number of enthusiastic volunteers from Teach Learn Grow into their school to tutor the students for a week.

Education is the most important thing that we can give our kids to ensure that they are on the right track to a brighter future. However, on average, remote students are 2 years behind metropolitan schools, and students in remote locations are 12 times more likely to be below the national minimum standard in Mathematics. Furthermore, 3 in 5 Indigenous kids living in remote areas will never finish school. This educational gap between urban and rural students mean that remote and rural students are often severely disadvantaged when it comes to educational opportunities.



Teach Learn Grow (TLG) is a not-for-profit organization that sends over 270 volunteers, biannually, across WA to offer one-to-one tutoring for a week to help make a change for kids across WA. Their mission is to help bridge the gap of educational disadvantage in WA. Every child deserves to have equal opportunities in education, which is why TLG aims to improve the educational outcomes and aspirations of remote students in socio-disadvantaged areas so that they can reach their full potential.



From the 26th of June to the 30th of June, the volunteer's interacted with the wider school cohort each day and immersed themselves in the local community. By sending these well-educated volunteers to tutor and act as positive role models to the students, TLG aims to improve our students' educational achievements and their value towards their education. Above all, they are striving to empower our students to reach their educational goals and potentials, and to see schooling in a more positive light!



But their efforts don't just end there. With the help of sponsors such as ECU, TLG has been able to thrive and thus effectively help our students at Gnowangerup District High School reach their full educational potential. TLG also provides an eMentor program throughout the schooling terms, and will also be back again for the second part of their bi-annual rural program at the end of the year! 



If anyone has any information about this matter, do not hesitate to contact the Shire or the Gnowangerup Police.




