Despite it being a wet and windy day, on Monday 13th June Hon. Tuck Waldon MLA and Peter Rundle braved the weather to present a cheque to the Shire of Gnowangerup from Lotterywest for \$180,945 toward the new Gnowangerup Community Swimming Pool Redevelopment project.

The additional funds will provide a variety of extra features to the new facility including beautifully landscaped gardens, lawn and play area, shade shelters and improvements to the grounds.

“The Gnowangerup Swimming Pool redevelopment project has been an important project for the local community”, Mr Waldron said.

“Not only will it allow the continued provision of aquatic activities for the region into the future; its new location also creates a sporting hub for residents where both winter and summer sports can be enjoyed.”

“The additional funds that have been received will allow for a more inviting space for users.”

Community members may have noticed contractors McCorkell Constructions have now left site after obtaining practical completion in May. Staff at McCorkell Constructions have provided a fantastic facility, despite battling the trying weather of January and juggling some last minute decisions made by the Swimming Pool Committee. Committee President Travis Hawkins briefly spoke about the concourse and some of the issues faced.

“Whilst it’s unfortunate we were unable receive the stencilled finish we were after for the concourse, a run of bad luck with commissioning available sub-contractors meant we were left with no option other than the pewter coloured finish we now have”.

“Regardless, as a committee we are very happy with the final product and look forward to seeing all aspects of the project come together”.

With funds now secured, the landscaping component of the project is underway. Local landscaping contractor BGL Solutions was awarded the contract, and staff have been busy levelling the site, laying reticulation and filling planter boxes since the beginning of June. It is expected that planting will be finished by the end of June and turf will be laid with the community’s help in the first few weeks of July. Details of the Community Landscaping day will be released in the coming weeks.

Open Day: Community invited to visit Gnowangerup Health Service

Local community members are invited to an Open Day on June 29 at the Gnowangerup Health Service which was refurbished last year as part of the Southern Inland Health Initiative (SIHI).

Acting Director of Nursing and Health Service Manager in the Central Great Southern, Robyn Millar, said there was an official opening held in December but not all locals were able to attend and view the new facilities and improved services.

“Community members will be able to tour our facilities and get an appreciation of what we offer and to ask questions about our services,” Ms Millar said.

“We are also using the opportunity to discuss the important issue of men’s mental health and we encourage people to come and listen to our guest speakers who will share their knowledge on the topic.”

Open Day date:

June 29, 2016 from 5pm – 8pm

Guest speakers:

6pm – 6.30pm: Tracey Kippin

Tracey Kippin lives on the family farm in Woodanilling where her husband suicided in 2009 following a long battle with depression. Tracey speaks publicly about her experience helping communities recognise the danger signs in loved ones.

7pm – 7.30pm: Men’s Resource Centre

Grant and Bruce from the Men’s Resource Centre in Albany will share their expertise about men’s mental health. The Men’s Resource Centre is a not-for-profit, community organisation focused on raising awareness of men’s wellbeing and physical, emotional and psychological health issues.

Open Day activities:

- Tour of the facility.
- Emergency Telehealth Service demonstration - using videoconferencing to treat people in the Emergency Department.
- Information on Patient Assisted Travel Scheme (PATS) which provides subsidies for fuel and accommodation costs to eligible patients traveling for care.

- Information about allied health services (physiotherapy, occupational therapy, Dietetics) and Home and Community Care services (HACC) which support elderly people to remain in their own homes for as long as possible.
- Information from the Aged Care Unit on residential aged care including permanent and respite care options.
- Eye health checks for diabetes sufferers.
- Free sausage sizzle.

The Gnowangerup Health Service refurbishment was funded by the State Government's Royalties for Regions as part of the half a billion dollar Southern Inland Health Initiative being delivered by the WA Country Health Service.

The Southern Inland Health Initiative's \$300 million capital works program is more extensive and complex than any project previously undertaken by the WA Country Health Service, with new builds and upgrades to 37 hospitals and health services in the Great Southern, Wheatbelt, South West and Midwest.

In the Great Southern, Kojonup Health Service, Tambellup Health Centre and Katanning Health Service refurbishments are all part of the Southern Inland Health Initiative's capital upgrade program. In addition to the capital works component, communities in the central Great Southern region are benefitting from a number of health improvements, including increased numbers of GPs and significantly improved emergency medical care thanks to SIHI.

The Emergency Telehealth Service is connecting local doctors and nurses treating patients in emergency departments (EDs) at Gnowangerup, Katanning and Kojonup hospitals with highly trained emergency medical specialists in Perth via videoconference.

Incentives offered under SIHI are supporting more doctors to live and work locally and take part in ED rosters. Under SIHI, there has been a demonstrated 67 per cent improvement in the GP retention rate at the SIHI four year mark, indicative of the program's success in supporting and retaining GPs in regional communities (Rural Health West data).

SIHI has also significantly increased the range of local health services that bring care closer to home in the central Great Southern and help people to avoid hospital including a diabetes educator who visits Kojonup, Tambellup and Gnowangerup regularly, a community midwifery service providing shared antenatal care with local GPs, a nurse practitioner who provides home visits delivering primary care, including for mental health clients, Health Navigator supporting people living with chronic conditions and outpatient appointments via telehealth videoconferencing with specialists based in metropolitan and larger regional hospitals.



SHIRE PRESIDENTS REPORT

Council business for May was very varied. Council was able to support expressions of intent for business expansion with two agenda items; these items are always very encouraging in terms of community benefit. The proposed sale of land resulting from the successful planning department endorsement of lot 556 Structure Plan continues the development of the old water corp site into a valued business location.

In terms of community assets, two items were raised at very different ends of the spectrum. The pool project reached the exciting contractual milestone of practical completion on Friday 13 May 2016 and the landscaping of the pool surrounds will commence in mid June.

Obsolete television transmission towers were approved for disposal and may create an opportunity for someone to reshape & utilise old assets. The other significant item was the endorsement of the 2016/17 firebreak order; this will be included with rate notices in the usual manner. Congratulations and thank you to all brigade members on their appointments in the necessary roles for the year.

The Shire also conducted a business forum in May, guest speakers included representatives from Western Power, LandCorp, the Great Southern Development Commission and Water Corp. It was pleasing to have a great range of businesses attend from across the shire, and we hope all were able to take something away from the morning. I believe the organisations that presented appreciated the feed back received. Amongst many issues raised, two points of interest were regarding the future of remote power provision, and waste water treatment management.

Works are currently being undertaken to repair the road network damaged by the storm on the 20th January. Due to the extend of the damage it is likely that these works will take between 12—18 months to complete. Although it is an inconvenience to rate payers the shire will benefit from having a renewed asset largely funded through grants and which will not require renewal for some time.

STANDPIPE FEE AND CHARGE

The adopted 2015/16 Annual Budget identified that an electronic swipe card system was to be installed at the Gnowangerup Standpipe for all hours access.

The Shire of Gnowangerup has implemented the system and imposed a fee of \$22.00 (GST inclusive) for the supply of an individual card.
